

Directions to 'Leopard' at Ocean Village Marina

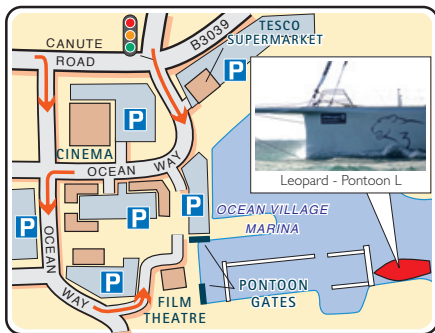
Leopard

From M25:

- Exit M25 junction 12 onto the M3 towards Southampton
- Continue on M3 exiting at junction 14 onto the A33 towards Southampton City Centre
- At the first roundabout take the second exit onto the A33
- Follow the A33 until another large roundabout 'Charlotte Place'
- Take the second exit onto the A33 Northam Road and follow the signs towards the waterfront
- Take the right lane approaching the first set of traffic lights
- Turn right onto the A33 St Mary's Place still following signs for the waterfront
- Continue on this road onto Terminus Terrace and follow until a 'T' junction is reached
- Turn left onto Canute Road and then take the second right at the traffic lights into ocean way - you are now at Ocean Village
- Once in Ocean Village Marina, parking is readily available in a selection of 'Pay and Display' car parks (change required)
- Leopard is a short walk from all car parks and can be reached by walking through either pontoon gate noted overleaf (gate code tbc)
- Leopard is moored at the far end of the Marina on Pontoon 'L' (noted overleaf). You will be able to see the Leopard3 battleflag flying from the gates
